WHAT'S NEW AT WEST MEMORIAL OFFICE PARK

Welcome to Spring Valley Town Center, also known as West Memorial Park and Memorial Design Center. The purpose of this Newsletter is to keep our Tenants updated on current events, facility upgrades, tenant services and neighborhood news.

Your suggestions for improvements around the campus have provided us with valuable insight into how we can provide the best quality and most cost efficient improvements to you, our valued Tenants.

We look forward to wrapping up the 2019 year and looking into ways to better serve you. Ownership has been working with several vendors to provide the most aesthetic and efficient Complex amenities, while keeping your controllable CAM expenses in line with previous years.

2019 has been an active year for performing improvements and preventative maintenance throughout the Complex. Our HVAC systems, including the package units on the roofs of the smaller buildings, are enrolled in a Preventative Maintenance Program to assist with identifying and diagnosing any potential problems before they occur. This Program has exposed several components throughout the various HVAC systems that needed attention and these components have been repaired or replaced prior to mechanical failure. These type of preventative programs are vital in helping to keep our systems running especially during the summer months.

We have recently completed painting the exterior of the 8584/8588 building. This will provide a more aesthetic exterior and will assist in combating water intrusion which might be caused by aged grout and brickwork. .

The product we are using, **Elastomeric paint**, is an excellent option as it provides a tough and thick coating that also waterproofs most surfaces. Elastomeric coating is also resistant to heat, cold, sunlight, and rain.
